


REFERENCE ON ENTRY REQUIREMENTS OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN

(For citizens of all countries*)

As of August 25, 2021

Enter to the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan by plane or train:













People visiting the Republic of Uzbekistan by air and rail are required to provide a certificate confirming a negative result for coronavirus infection only by means of PPCR, within not more than 72 hours before registration of air or rail traffic to arrive in the Republic of Uzbekistan.














At the entrance to the Republic of Uzbekistan by air and rail, the order of entry into the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan without any restrictions is maintained with a certificate of vaccination recognized internationally in the fight against coronavirus infection or with a certificate of antibodies against coronavirus infection in the blood, established by the Protocol of the Special Commission of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

* Except travellers arriving from India and Pakistan.



People entering the Republic through road border checkpoints undergo express testing for coronavirus antigen at their own expense and will be allowed to enter the country only if a certificate with a negative result is provided










Regardless of the presence of a visitor's certificate of a negative result of PCR test, persons entering through road border checkpoints receive a rapid test for coronavirus infection antigen at their own expense in special clinics or laboratories operating at border checkpoints

Entering through border checkpoints, citizens and stateless people permanently residing in the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan with a positive result of test are placed in medical institutions specializing in the treatment of coronavirus infections located in the respective territory.



Are accommodated in a hotel until the result of a laboratory PCR test is received;
Laboratory PCR test is carried out in the prescribed manner.

Citizens entering the Republic of Uzbekistan from Pakistan and India are allowed to enter the country after a 14-day quarantine.

Regardless of the aircraft capacity, foreign nationals arriving from Pakistan and India on the same flight will be accommodated in one hotel, while citizens arriving on a different aircraft will be accommodated in a different hotel.

Citizens undergoing treatment from

Pakistan and India are allowed to stay in

private hospitals during the quarantine

period according to their health conditions.



At present in the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan there is still a requirement for citizens to wear medical masks, maintain social distance, to carry out disinfection work.

Foreign nationals and stateless persons not residing permanently in the Republic of Uzbekistan shall not be allowed to enter to the Republic of Uzbekistan

* Exceptions are made for foreign nationals and stateless people permanently residing in the Republic of Uzbekistan.
